



Gravel Haulers and Resident Ratepayers with Equipment for 2017

County resident ratepayers with trucks and other equipment wanting to work for the County in **2017** must register their equipment or they will not be contacted to provide equipment or services. **Those with equipment other than gravel trucks, please include your hourly rate.**

If we do not have a minimum of eight (8) local gravel truckers registered by **February 10, 2017** and committed for both the spring haul and summer haul, we will be advertising for out of County trucks as per Policy 913 which includes the load factor and haul rates for gravelling.

The County will be hauling gravel in March **2017**.

Any trucks hauling gravel on the spring haul must be winter equipped with working vibrators. This mainly applies to clam and belly dumps, which are prone to plugging in spring gravelling. **Any trucks that cannot make their spreads will not be used.**

The County will haul approximately 55,000 tonnes of gravel in March **2017**.

- 2) YOU MUST CARRY \$2,000,000.00 GENERAL LIABILITY INSURANCE**
- 3) YOU MUST CARRY \$2,000,000.00 AUTO LIABILITY INSURANCE**
- 4) A CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE SHOWING THORHILD COUNTY NAMED AS AN “ADDITIONAL INSURED” UNDER THE GENERAL LIABILITY INSURANCE MUST BE SUBMITTED TO PUBLIC WORKS BEFORE EQUIPMENT CAN BE USED.**
- 5) CLEARANCE LETTER FROM WCB**
 - GRAVEL HAULERS – PW WILL REQUEST FROM WCB**
 - ALL OTHERS WITH EQUIPMENT – SUBMIT WCB WITH REGISTRATION FORM.**
- 6) GST NUMBER – IF YOU ARE GST REGISTERED**
- 7) ALL TRUCKS MUST HAVE WORKING VIBRATORS AND CB RADIOS**
- 8) GRAVEL TRUCKS MUST HAVE WORKING TARPS – ALL LOADS MUST BE TARPED**
